

**NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS
2025 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT
SPECIFICATION NO. PW2025-06
IN THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Calabasas as AGENCY, invites bids for **the above stated project and will receive such bids in the form of submission by email up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., on Tuesday the 28th day of October, 2025 as instructed in project's webpage. The bids will be opened and posted on Project webpage on City of Calabasas website at 2:40 p.m. on the 28th day of October, 2025.**

The 2025 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT to be constructed consists of resurfacing Las Virgenes Rd and Lilac Trail and Gladiola Dr located in the Calabasas Highlands. The project to be constructed consists of the CONTRACTOR furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the plans, specifications, and contract documents for the cold-planing, reconstruction or repair of city streets and segments in the City of Calabasas. The work includes but not be limited to - saw-cutting; excavation, removal and disposal of the AC roadway section; cold-planing and disposal of AC pavement; replacement and compaction of subsurface material; setup and maintenance of temporary traffic control system; placement of crushed miscellaneous base and AC pavement materials; rehabilitation of berms and dikes; replacement of traffic striping and markings; and cleanup of the project area; and digout and patching of alligator cracked areas. The project areas could border residential homes; therefore, it is critical that noise and dust should be kept at a minimum during construction. Traffic control should be set up to allow for complete access to the offsite residents and businesses. This project is partly funded by an STPL federal grant and as such, is subject to federal compliance and procedures from bidding to closing of the project. Bidders are encouraged to review Caltrans STPL funding procedures prior to bidding.

The plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available to download electronically through the City of Calabasas project [webpage](#) starting Friday, September 26, 2025. Prospective bidders must review the document titled "Application Instructions" to make sure a full package is submitted for review. Failure to provide all required information and documents will disqualify the bidder. In order to bid for the project, the Bid shall be prepared on the approved bid forms provided by the City in conformance with INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.

In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code § 7028.15(e), the AGENCY has determined that the contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license at the time that the contract is awarded. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder's bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award.

CONTRACTORS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE LICENSED AND REGULATED BY THE CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD. ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING A CONTRACTOR MAY BE REFERRED TO THE REGISTRAR, CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD, P.O. BOX 2600, SACRAMENTO, CA 95826. At the time the contract is awarded, the contractor shall be properly licensed in accordance with the laws of this state. The first payment for

work or material shall not be made unless and until the Registrar of Contractors verifies to the AGENCY that the records of the Contractors' State License Board indicate that the contractor was properly licensed at the time the contract was awarded. Any bidder or contractor not so licensed shall be subject to all legal penalties imposed by law including, but not limited to, any appropriate disciplinary action by the Contractors' State Board. Failure of the bidder to obtain proper and adequate licensing for an award of a contract shall constitute a failure to execute the contract and shall result in the forfeiture of the security of the bidder. (Public Contract Code § 20103.5)

CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS FOR ANY BID PROPOSAL SUBMITTED ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 2015, AND FOR ANY CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC WORK ENTERED INTO ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2015. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed on a bid proposal for, or perform any public work contract unless it is currently registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations as described in Labor Code § 1725.5.

Bids must be prepared on the approved bid forms in conformance with INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS and submitted in the manner instructed in "Application Instructions" document provided in the project webpage.

The selected bidder is required to submit a bid guarantee in the amount of 10% of the total bid by bid due date as shown on the schedule. All bids for the project shall be presented using the following forms of bidder's security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid: (a) a cashier's check made payable to the City of Calabasas; (b) a money order, (c) a certified check made payable to the City of Calabasas; or (d) a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, made payable to the City of Calabasas. Such security shall be forfeited should the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to timely execute the contract and to deliver the necessary bonds and insurance certificates as specified in the contract documents.

To the extent applicable, at any time during the term of the Agreement for the proposed project, the successful bidder may, at its own expense, substitute securities equivalent to the amount withheld as retention (or the retained percentage) in accordance with Public Contract Code § 22300.

Pursuant to California Civil Code § 9550, a payment bond is required to be submitted for all projects estimated in excess of \$25,000.00.

The AGENCY has determined that the proposed project is a public works subject to the provisions of Labor Code § 1720 thereby requiring the Contractor to pay the prevailing wage rates for all work performed under the Contract. Accordingly, the proposed project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California Department of Industrial Relations.

The AGENCY reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
